

# Miss Weber County Scholarship Pageant 2009

## Rules & Regulations

---

1. Official paperwork for the pageant must be filled out and submitted to the Miss Weber County pageant director on or before 5pm of February 27, 2009. (Exceptions must be arranged through the pageant director.)
2. Contestant must reside, work or attend school in Weber County for six months prior to the pageant and be a citizen of the United States.
3. When the contestant is selected "Miss Weber County", she agrees to enter the "Miss Utah Scholarship Pageant" with Weber County as her sponsor.
4. Contestants' age on March 13, 2009 cannot be less than 17 and not more than 25 by January 1 of the year in which she will compete at the Miss America Pageant.
5. As Miss Weber County you must have a valid Utah drivers license and have the means to commute to and from meetings and activities you are required to be at.
6. The Miss Weber County Scholarship Pageant committee has the right to choose and designate wardrobe, hairstyle, make-up and make any other decisions which, in their judgment, help a representative be better prepared for the Miss Utah Pageant and the year as Miss Weber County. Each contestant agrees to make herself available for any and all meetings that will help achieve all of the above.
7. Contestants chosen as Weber County Royalty, a queen and two attendants, will be expected to attend certain activities during their reign. You will need to make arrangements with your job, family, school, etc. If you are unable to fulfill your obligations as a member of the royalty, please advise the pageant director, Jan Wilson, before the pageant begins.
8. Contestants are expected to act in a manner above reproach at all times, keeping in mind that they are representing the county and the Weber County Fair.
9. Please leave all valuables and cell phones at home. Come prepared. Be responsible for all personal items such as toiletries, hair items etc.
10. Each contestant will be assigned a hostess during the pageant. This hostess will be there to assist you. Parents, family and friends are not allowed backstage.
11. The Miss America Organization has adopted a national platform, Children's Miracle Network. All contestants competing in a local, state or national pageant are required to raise money for this platform. For Miss Weber County (local) the amount is \$100. Each contestant will need to register on line at [www.MissAmerica4Kids.org](http://www.MissAmerica4Kids.org) A copy of your Children's Miracle Network account will need to be turned at rehearsal to show the money has been raised and you are eligible to compete.  
An additional \$100 needs to be paid to Weber County. This \$100 will cover 15 tickets that you will receive. These tickets may be given to sponsors, family, friends, etc. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$8.00 at the door.
