JD 04/02.00 INMATE TRANSFERS

JD 04/02.01 **Policy**

It is the policy of the WCCF that inmates be transferred to other jails, prisons, etc.:

- A. safely and securely;
- B. to facilitate judicial process; and
- C. to carry out a lawful sentence of a court having jurisdiction.

JD 04/02.02 Rationale

- A. This chapter covers the types of transfers which Utah jails usually process and does not cover temporary in-transit holds.
- B. Transferring an inmate to an out-of-state jail may impact the inmate's ability to maintain contact with his attorney. Therefore, careful consideration should be given by jail officials when transferring inmates without court order.
- C. Transfers to the Utah State Prison, when so ordered by the court, shall occur as prescribed by Utah State Law.

JD 04/02.03 Procedure: Inmate Transfers

A. Pre-Trial Prisoners

- 1. Pre-trial inmates shall not be transferred to an out-of-state facility unless ordered by a court having jurisdiction.
- 2. Pre-trial inmates should not be transferred to another facility within the same state if the transfer would result in denying the prisoner reasonable access to his attorney or the court.
- 3. Inmates shall be released consistent with WCCF policy JC 04, Release Process.
- 4. Absent a court order, the WCCF Jail Commander shall be responsible for the authorization of transfer of inmates who are in the custody of the WCCF.

B. Convicted Inmates

1. Convicted inmates may be transferred to an out-of-state facility or to another facility within the state:

- a. when ordered by a court having jurisdiction; and/or
- b. when the transfer is necessary to maintain safety, security, and good order of the WCCF.
- 2. Inmates shall be released consistent with WCCF policy JC 04, Release Process.
- 3. Absent a court order, the WCCF Jail Commander shall be responsible for the authorization of transfer of inmates who are in custody of the WCCF.

JD 04/02.04 **Procedure: Prison Commitments**

- A. When a prison commitment is issued by the court, the OTS shall be processed consistent with WCCF policy JB 10, OTS Court Tracking.
- B. WCCF Records Unit staff shall schedule the transfer of inmates from the WCCF to the Utah State Prison. The transfer should take place within five (5) days of the sentencing.
- C. Prior to the scheduled transfer, WCCF Records Unit staff shall deliver the release authorization paperwork to WCCF Release staff.
- D. Inmates shall be released consistent with WCCF policy JC 04, Release Process.
