a. **Procedure**

- 2.4.1 During an event which depletes County resources, the Weber County Commission may activate the County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) to obtain needed resources and facilities coordination with the State. In such case the County Commission would also declare a state of emergency.
- 2.4.2 During a declared state of emergency, mutual aid from the state or federal government shall be requested by the Weber County Commission or designee of the Commission, if the Commission is unavailable.
- 2.4.3 State assistance, including assistance from the National Guard, is requested through the office of the Governor. Access to the Governors Office during a state of emergency is through the State Department of Public Safety, Division of Comprehensive Emergency Management, Emergency Operations Center (EOC).
- 2.4.4 Federal assistance is requested through the Office of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), through the State EOC.
