11.11 Policy

- 11.11.1 The training of volunteers is a unique task, therefore, each of the volunteer groups will be trained according to the duties they have agreed to perform. The training will be coordinated through the SAR/Fleet Section administrative sergeant and/or volunteer coordinator.
- 11.11.2 Auxiliary Deputies' duties include carrying an authorized weapon and making arrests under the supervision of a sworn deputy. Auxiliary deputies must:
 - A. Receive Utah P.O.S.T. certification training and be certified as Peace Officers.
 - B. Be trained in use-of-force policies and,
 - C. Be tested for firearms proficiency with the same frequency and using the same curriculum as full-time deputies.
 - D. Receive in-service training equivalent to that required for full-time officers performing like functions.
