Re: Protective Orders/Jail Release Agreements #12-06

Utah law prohibits the release of an individual from jail prior to the accused's first judicial appearance if that individual is arrested for violating a criminal protective order issued by the jail (jail release agreement or "No Contact Order").

In accordance with Utah State Code 77-20-1 (3)(b) and 77-36-2.5, individuals who are arrested for violating the jail release agreement will be held without bail pending their first judicial appearance.
