18.1 Purpose

18.1.1 The Weber County Sheriff's Office Code of Conduct is intended to be an articulation of this organization's values as they relate to the behavior of all Sheriff's Office personnel.

18.2 Policy

- 18.2.1 The Weber County Sheriff's Office issues all members, a copy of the Code of Conduct, which specifies a standard for the conduct and appearance of Office personnel.
 - A. The Code of Conduct may be found at the end of each policy and procedures manual issued by the Office.
 - B. All members shall be familiar with the Code of Conduct. The Office will provide orientation training regarding the Code of Conduct for newly hired employees as well as ongoing training for current employees at least once annually. Such annual training may be included as part of the Office "critical" policy testing.
