28.6 Purpose

- 28.6.1 The purpose of the community/service area assignment is to affix accountability for providing law enforcement services within that geographical service area.

28.7 Definition

- 28.7.1 Community - Represents the geographic service area containing sufficient workload for a single deputy during a single shift.

28.8 Policy

- A. The authority to assign deputies to communities rests with the shift supervisor or his/her superior.
 - B. Deputies will generally be assigned to communities based upon Office needs. The shift supervisor may also assign deputies to particular communities exhibiting peculiar crime problems based upon each deputy's individual police skills, to facilitate employee development, training, unusual circumstances, or community based initiatives.
- 28.8.1 Frequency of Community/Service Area Rotation
- A. The assignment of communities/service areas will occur at each shift change. Community/Geographic based initiative assignments will normally require a one year

tour of duty.
