28.38 Policy

28.38.1 This Office recognizes that there are activities that pose a higher than usual risk to the safety of deputies. Often these activities or operations are planned for. For such pre-planned, high risk operations (such as S.W.A.T. operations, Narcotics raids, high risk warrants, etc.) Deputies WILL wear approved body armor.

- A. Wearing plain clothes instead of a law enforcement uniform does not exempt a deputy from the body armor requirement.
- B. Deputies engaged in appropriate undercover activities, when the wearing of body armor may alert suspects to a police presence and put the deputy at greater risk, are exempted from this requirement.
