## 29.8 Policy

- 29.8.1 Preliminary investigations may often lead to the successful conclusion of a case thus eliminating the need for follow-up investigation. The following steps should be completed as appropriate:
  - A. Observing all conditions, events, and remarks.
  - B. Locating and identifying witnesses.
  - C. Maintaining the crime scene and protecting evidence.
  - D. Interviewing the complainant and witnesses.
  - E. Interrogating the suspect (except for major crimes).
  - F. Arranging for the collection of evidence.
  - G. Effecting the arrest of the suspect.
  - H. Documenting the incident completely and accurately on the appropriate Weber County Sheriff's Office report forms and/or supplements.
- 29.8.2 The completion of a preliminary investigation will not preclude the primary deputy from being assigned to the follow-up investigation. This determination will be made by the deputy's supervisor.
