30.7 Policy

- 30.7.1 The WEBER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE may have equipment and trained personnel to conduct covert operations for the control of vice, drug and/or organized crime violations. Such actions may include, but are not limited to:
- A. Infiltration of suspected illegal operations
 - B. Decoy operations
 - C. Undercover operations
 - D. Surveillance operations
- 30.7.2 Covert operations will be approved by the Investigations Section Lieutenant, before any action is taken. **In case of drug violations overall supervision and approval of such investigations will be conducted by the Weber-Morgan Narcotic Strike Force Commander or his designee.**
- 30.7.3 All necessary equipment will be obtained according to the previous section.
- 30.7.4 Other agencies within the State of Utah may provide any needed equipment and/or personnel, as requested by this agency.
- A. The Investigations Lieutenant and/or Operations Bureau Commander should oversee any such requests.
