31.1 Purpose

- 31.1.1 Contacts with juveniles, in both criminal and non-criminal situations, make up a significant portion of the contacts between the Sheriff's Office and public. Because of this, responsibility for juvenile operations cannot be relegated to a single unit or small group of persons within the Sheriff's Office. Each patrol officer, bailiff, court security officer and investigator is accountable for the proper handling of juvenile problems within the framework of UCA 62A-4a-201.

31.2 Policy

- 31.2.1 The Weber County Sheriff's Office is committed to the development and maintenance of programs to prevent and control juvenile delinquency, such programs include but are not limited to:
- A. Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.)
 - B. School Resource Officers
 - C. Serious Habitual Offender Comprehensive Action Program (SHOCAP)
