32.6 Policy

- 32.6.1 As part of the C.O.P. unit monthly report, the C.O.P. Sergeant shall include the following information, as appropriate, to the Sheriff, through the Operations Bureau Commander and Chief Deputy:
 - A. A description of current issues voiced by the community.
 - B. A description of potential problems that have a bearing on law enforcement activities within the community.
 - C. A statement of recommended actions that address identified concerns and problems.
 - D. A statement of progress made toward addressing previously identified concerns and problems.
 - E. A list of issues that may effect our community but may not be a police issue. As an involved member of our County, all issues impacting the citizens of our County become our issues also.
- 32.6.2 All C.O.P. personnel and other involved agency members shall submit progress reports regarding items specified in 32.6.1 to the C.O.P. Supervisor on a monthly and/or as needed basis to be utilized and/or included in the formulation of the monthly report.
