32.7 Policy

- 32.7.1 The WEBER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE will endeavor to conduct periodic surveys of citizen attitudes and opinions as they relate to:
 - A. Overall agency performance,
 - B. Overall competence of agency employees,
 - C. Deputies attitudes and behaviors toward citizens
 - D. Community safety and security concerns,
 - E. Recommendations and suggestions for improvement.
- 32.7.2 Sheriff's Office surveys should employ established research methods and the results of such surveys should be provided to the public. Surveys may be conducted by the Emergency Management and Planning Bureau or other personnel as directed.
- 32.7.3 Citizen surveys should be conducted on a biannual basis and may be conducted through the mail, in person, or by the telephone.
- 32.7.4 All surveys will have the prior approval of the Sheriff.
