33.2 Discussion

- 33.2.1 Weber County has developed a plan for responding to natural and man-made disasters, as well as, civil disturbances and extraordinary criminal events. The various functions outlined in the basic plan allow the broadest coverage in use.
- 33.2.2 Master copies of the emergency operations plan are maintained by the Sheriff, Chief Deputy, Bureau Commanders, individual County Department heads, County Commissioners Office, and in the emergency operations center. The plan is updated on a yearly basis under the overall direction of the Weber County Sheriff.

33.3 Purpose

- 33.3.1 The Sheriff's Office recognizes the importance of planning for natural and man-made disasters and will have appropriate plans so that Sheriff's Office members responding to such disasters will have written guidelines and procedures to follow.
- 33.3.2 The Sheriff's Office will make its members aware of the contents of such plans and will provide training with regard to the implementation of the plans.

32.4 Policy

- 32.4.1 The County may be party to a Multi-

jurisdictional Mutual Aid Agreement in conjunction with other local area agencies. Members of the Sheriff's Office will abide by the terms and conditions outlined in said document when or if an emergency operations plan is activated, and there is a signed agreement.

- A. Only the Weber County Commissioners, or a person designated to perform the Commissioner's duties in their absence, is authorized to activate the County Emergency Operations plan/Emergency Operations Center.
- B. If or when an emergency operations plan is activated, deputies will adhere to the procedures outlined in Weber County's Emergency Operations Plan(s), and will abide by the terms of any Memorandum of Understanding and/or Mutual Aid Agreement that may apply.
