## 41.5 Policy

- 41.5.1 A victim/witness will be able to receive emergency assistance through the Weber Area Consolidated Dispatch Center (WCDC) by calling 9-1-1 24 hours a day or through this office from 8:00am to 5:00pm.
- 41.5.2 A victim may be given the 24 hour telephone number to the DVA unit(399-8065).
- 41.5.3 The DVA unit may provide victims with referral information concerning where to get medical attention, counseling, and emergency financial assistance.
- 41.5.4 The DVA unit may upon the request by the officer in charge of the investigation inform families of murdered victims or those that have lost a family member due to crime, of all State and local resources including Crime Victim Reparations, grief and support counseling services and other financial or relevant sources of community support.
