41.7 Procedure

- 41.7.1 During the preliminary investigation of any incident the responding deputy or victim advocate will, as the need indicates:
- 41.7.2 Provide the victim/witness with information about applicable services, e.g., counseling, medical attention, compensation programs, and victim advocacy.
- 41.7.3 Advise the victim/witness about what to do if the suspect, suspect's companion, or family threatens or otherwise intimidates him/her.
- 41.7.4 Provide the incident case number, if known, as well as explaining subsequent steps that may follow with the case, investigation or possible prosecution.
- 41.7.5 Provide an avenue for reporting additional information about the case or to receive information about the case.
