## 41.8 Procedure

- 41.8.1 During the follow-up investigation, the investigator or victim advocate will provide the victim/witness with the following services:
  - A. If, in the opinion of the Office, the impact of a crime on a victim/witness has been unusually severe and has triggered above-average victim/witness assistance, recontacting the victim/witness periodically to determine whether needs are being met.
  - B. If not an endangerment to the successful prosecution of the case, explaining to victims/witnesses the procedures involved in the prosecution of their cases and their role in those procedures.
  - C. The Weber County Attorney's Office will provide scheduling of line-ups, interviews, and other required appearances at the convenience of the victim/witness.
  - D. If feasible, returning promptly victim/witness property taken as evidence (except for contraband, disputed property, and weapons used in the course of the crime), where permitted by law or rules of evidence.
  - E. If needed, assigning a victim advocate to the victim/witness during follow-up investigation at the discretion of the investigating agency.
