## 45.21 **Policy**

- 45.21.1 There may be times during the enforcement of the traffic laws that the individual deputy feels that a driver should be referred to the Driver's License Division for re-examination. The deputy shall complete the "Request for Driver's License Re-Examination" form. The deputy will notify the violator of the intent to have his/her privilege re-examined by the licensing authority. The request will be submitted to the on-duty patrol supervisor for review.
- 45.21.2 Criteria to assess the need for a reexamination of an individual's drivers license includes, but is not limited to, the following criteria:
  - A. Drivers who are suspected to be incompetent.
  - B. Physical or mental disability.
  - C. Disease.
  - D. Other conditions that might prevent the person from exercising reasonable and ordinary care while operating a motor vehicle.
  - E. Inability to safely operate a vehicle as shown by continued violations or hazardous driving behavior.
  - F. Request from a family member to have an elderly member's drivers license re-examined.

- 45.21.3 Procedure: Requests for Re-examination
  - A. Complete the "Request for Drivers License Reexamination" form.
  - B. Notify the driver/violator of the intent to send them to the Drivers License Division for re-examination.
  - C. Explain to the driver the reason for the reexamination.
  - D. Issue a citation if warranted.
  - E. Complete a report if appropriate, and/or notes on the citation, documenting the reason for the contact with the driver and the reasons for the re-examination request.
  - F. Submit the request form and related documents/citation to the on duty patrol supervisor for review.
  - G. The request form will be forwarded to the Central Services Section to be sent to the Utah State Drivers License Division.
