45.25 **Policy**

- 45.25.1 Deputies of this department will respond to accidents involving but not limited to any of the following:
 - A. Death or injury.
 - B. Hit and run.
 - C. Impairment of an operator due to alcohol or drugs.
 - D. Damage to public vehicles or property.
 - E. Hazardous materials.
 - F. Disturbances between principles.
 - G. Major traffic congestion as a result of the accident.
 - H. Total damage to vehicles of \$1000 or more and/or to the extent towing is required.
- 45.25.2 Services provided, or summoned, by the deputy at the scene of the accident should include, when appropriate, any of the following:
 - Emergency services, such as first aid, fire or paramedics,
 - B. Investigating the accident to determine cause,
 - C. Collecting and recording short lived evidence, by the deputy or CSI, in anticipation of civil or criminal adjudication,
 - D. Removal of inoperable or other vehicles from the scene,
 - E. Traffic control
 - F. Restoring normal flow of traffic to protect public safety.

- 45.25.3 The delay of a deputy's response to conduct a complete accident investigations will occur at the discretion of the shift supervisor following careful consideration of:
 - A. Weather emergencies.
 - B. Work load priority.
 - C. Staffing level available.
 - D. Appropriateness of alternative response.
