45.28 **Procedure**

- 45.28.1 Steps to be followed when conducting accident follow up investigations may include but are not limited to:
 - A. Ensuring all preliminary and supplementary reports are completed.
 - B. Comprehensive review of preliminary and supplementary reports for details of the accident.
 - C. Examination of the accident scene.
 - D. Collecting off-scene data including, but not limited to:
 - 1. Medical records.
 - 2. Physicians' reports.
 - 3. Blood tests.
 - 4. Driver physical handicaps.
 - 5. Vehicle mechanical inspections.
 - 6. Laboratory reports.
 - E. Reviewing or Obtaining Witness Statements
 - 1. Signed witness reports at accident scenes.
 - 2. Interviews of witnesses who have left the scene, as soon as possible, by phone or in person.
 - 3. Re-interview of witnesses/victims/suspects/deputies

- 4. Signed statements should be obtained whenever possible.
- 5. Office witness statement forms should be used when obtaining written statements.
- F. Accident Reconstruction, Expert and Technical Assistance
 - 1. Reconstruction and skid analysis may be conducted on a case-by-case basis by the investigator or other deputies or personnel trained in these areas.
 - 2. Experts or Technical Assistance from outside the office may be utilized. They include but are not limited to:
 - a. Reconstruction experts.
 - b. Vehicle inspection teams.
 - c. Skid experts.
 - d. Traffic engineering.
 - e. State crime lab.
 - f. Photographic personnel.
 - g. Utah Highway Patrol
- G. Review of Evidence and Facts of the Case to determine causes of the accident, and criminal or traffic violations.
- H. Preparation of Formal Reports
 - 1. State of Utah Traffic Collision Report,
 - 2. Supplement collision report forms,
 - 3. Case report supplemental forms for additional narrative.
- I. Submit final reports for supervisory review and/or prosecution.
