## 45.39 **Definitions**

- 45.39.1 Such adverse conditions may be defined, for our purposes, as:
  - A. Accidental Such as debris falling onto the roadway from a vehicle, etc.
  - B. Acts of nature Such as fog, rain, ice, snow, etc.
  - C. Engineered Such as an open manhole cover, a damaged road surface from a water break, or any other object that may cause unnecessary damage or injury should a vehicle, for any reason, impact with such object either on the roadway or upon entering/leaving the roadway.
  - D. Any damaged or turned road signs, malfunctioning or burnt-out traffic lights, or any damaged or blocked traffic control signs.

## 45.40 Policy

45.40.1 Upon discovery of any of the above, the deputies shall cause the appropriate person(s) to be notified for the purpose of correcting said conditions and, if necessary, implement traffic control to prevent damage or injury. The deputy shall document the information to include a disposition of the incident.
