## 45.44 Policy

- 45.44.1 The primary responsibility for the Office public traffic safety education effort shall be that of the Patrol Section Lieutenant along with support by the Community Oriented Policing Unit. That responsibility, however, may be shared by all members of the Office.
  - A. Both Patrol Section Lieutenant or designee and the COP unit may provide presentations in traffic safety education to schools, public and private agencies, and the community as requested.
  - B. The Office currently provides a Traffic Class once a month for referrals from the Justice Court for minor traffic offenders.
  - C. Each deputy should be apprized of the basic facts relating to traffic safety, as such information may be requested from him/her by the public. The deputy may also refer citizens or community organizations to the Motor Unit Sergeant, or the community resource deputies for more detailed information or presentations.
