45.50 **Policy**

- 45.50.1 A motorcycle accident, as it applies to policy shall include, but not be limited to, the following criteria:
 - A. The motorcycle sustains damage due to collision of any kind.
 - B. The motorcycle rider or anyone is injured, however slight, as a result of the operation of an Office motorcycle.
 - C. Damage is done to any property; personal, County or other property of value.
- 45.50.2 The motorcycle accident shall be reported in accordance with department and County accident reporting policy and procedures.
- 45.50.3 Accidents, including those related to training, shall be reported to the Motor Sergeant. The written report shall be placed in the motor training file, and in the file of the deputy involved.
- 45.50.4 Damage to motorcycles shall be reported to the maintenance and repair shop, with all applicable detail.
