47.9 Purpose

47.9.1 To provide directives to transporting deputy in those situations in which a prisoner wishes to communicate with others or others wish to communicate with prisoner.

47.10 **Policy**

- 47.10.1 Due to the difficulty in providing security and safety to the public, the prisoner, and the transporting deputy, a prisoner being transported to, from, or between custodial facilities, will not be allowed to communicate with others outside the transporting vehicle.
 - A. All requests for such communication shall be denied by the transporting deputy.
 - B. When transporting prisoners to the correctional facility after an arrest, the transporting deputy may explain to persons requesting the communication the following:
 - 1. The destination of the prisoner.
 - 2. The availability or lack of visitor facilities at the destination.
 - 3. Whether the prisoner will have access to a telephone at the destination.
 - 4. Any other information pertinent to the availability of the prisoner for communication at the destination.
- 47.10.2 When transporting in-custody prisoners to

court or other correctional facilities, the transporting deputy, for security purposes, will not provide information to unauthorized persons regarding the following:

- 1. Destination
- 2. Time of transport
- 3. Any other information that may compromise security
