#### 47.15      **Purpose**

- 47.15.1      The purpose is to provide a directive for notification of the court and the judge when a prisoner, to be transported to court, is considered a security hazard.

#### 47.16      **Policy**

- 47.16.1      If a prisoner to be transported to the court is believed to be or presents, a security hazard, the Courts Section Supervisor shall be notified immediately. Jurisdictions to which the prisoner is being transported should also be notified.

#### 47.17      **Procedure**

- 47.17.1      The Courts Section supervisor shall then:
- A.      Contact the court involved and make arrangements for necessary and reasonable security measures agreeable with the judge involved. This may include, but not be limited to:
    - 1.      Extra deputies assigned to courtroom security.
    - 2.      A search of the courtroom and places the prisoner may be held.
    - 3.      Searches of those entering the courtroom by hand or metal detector(s).
    - 4.      Keeping the prisoner in restraints in the courtroom.
  - B.      The Courts Section supervisor may assign

additional deputies to accompany the transporting deputy.
