## 47.20 **Purpose**

47.20.1 To provide guidelines for situations where deputies transport prisoners of the opposite sex.

## 47.21 **Policy**

- 47.21.1 A reasonable effort shall be made to ensure that the transporting deputy is of the same sex as the prisoner that is to be transported.
- 47.21.2 In all transports of prisoners, the transporting deputy(s) will notify communications of his/her location and mileage, when the transport begins and ends, and at any stop-over in between. These times will be recorded by communications.
- 47.21.3 If there are any unusual occurrences during transport of a prisoner of the opposite sex or if there is reason to believe that the actions of the transporting deputy may be called into question, the transporting deputy should notify the supervisor immediately. The supervisor may request that the transporting deputy provide a report concerning his/her actions and the details of the transport. The deputy's report will be given an IA number and placed in the IAU file. See chapter 38, Internal Affairs Investigations.
