## 48.6 Policy

- 48.6.1 The Weber County Sheriff's Office ensures holding cells/areas in the District and Juvenile Court buildings; and in the Sheriff's Office Complex are inspected to identify conditions conducive to harboring or breeding insects, rodents, or other vermin.
- 48.6.2 Ogden District Court Building/Holding Facility and Juvenile Court Building:
  - A. State owned buildings inspected by the Utah State DFCM for sanitation and pest control. DFCM contracts with approved vendors to respond to pest control complaints as needed and to clean holding cells on a daily basis.
  - B. Documented sanitation and pest control inspections are conducted once a month as part of the DFCM programmed maintenance schedule.
- 48.6.3 Deputies assigned to the District Court and Juvenile Court will conduct a weekly sanitary inspection to insure no insects, rodents or other unsanitary conditions exist in the holding areas/cells.
- 48.6.4 The holding cells in the Sheriff's Office Complex will be inspected for sanitary conditions by the Patrol Bureau commander or designee as part of the weekly facility inspection (Chapter 48.10; Standard 72.4.6).
