48.17 Procedure

- 48.17.1 In the event a detainee is in need of medical assistance, deputies shall:
 - A. Notify the Control Center or call 9-11 immediately.
 - B. Request emergency medical response.
 - C. Provide the pertinent information, including location and type of injury or illness.
 - D. If necessary, the deputy on scene shall provide first aid until medical responders arrive.
 - E. Other deputies responding to assist shall maintain order and secure the area.
- 48.17.2 Ogden Second District Court
 - A. First aid kits are available in each court room, control room, and main floor of the court building.
 - B. An inspection of the first aid kit will be made once a week and documented on the Facilities Inspection Sheet.
 - C. A report of any items used or missing from the first aid kit will be made to the court section supervisor. The items will be ordered and replaced as soon as possible.

- 48.17.3 Juvenile Court
 - A. First aid kits are available in the holding cell area and the front door security desk.
 - 1. An inspection of the first aid kit will be made once a week and documented on the Facilities Inspection Sheet.
 - 2. A report of any items used or missing from the first aid kit will be made to the court section supervisor. The items will be ordered and replaced as soon as possible.
 - B. In event of an injury in a court room, the Bailiff shall call the security desk for assistance. A deputy at the security desk shall respond with the first aid kit to assist the injured person.
- 48.17.4 Sheriff's Office Complex, Temporary Detention Holding Cells
 - A. First aid kits are maintained in the Patrol Section and Investigations Section offices for use by deputies in the event of minor injury to personnel or detainees.
 - The Patrol Duty Lieutenant and the Investigations Section Lieutenant or their designees are responsible for a weekly documented inspection of the Section first aid kits.
 - Missing items will be documented, ordered if necessary, and replaced as soon as possible.
 - B. In case of injury or the need for medical assistance deputies may call dispatch, 9-11, or may call the Correctional Facility medical staff.
- 48.17.5 Procedures for gaining access to medical services are posted in areas used by detainees, in English and Spanish.
