48.24 Policy

- 48.24.1 The WEBER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE will provide, in a timely manner, each arrestee or detained person with access to facilities, products, and/or personnel, to meet any necessary physical needs that might arise. The arresting or detaining deputy or his/her designee will ensure such needs are met. These facilities may include, but are not limited to:
- A. Restrooms. A restroom and water is provided in the Patrol and Detective Sections holding cells for arrestees and detained persons. In addition common restrooms are available in the Operations Bureau Area if necessary.
 - B. Personal hygiene products for female arrestees, only if detained in the Weber County Correctional Facility.
 - C. Drinking fountain/water.
 - D. Medical care, if needed or requested by the arrestee and/or deputy.
- 48.24.2 Temporary holding cells will be maintained at the current established building code occupancy requirements for lighting, ventilation and circulation of fresh air. (See P&P Chapter 48.3.1)
