50.5 Policy

- 50.5.1 Execution of Civil Warrants and Writs
 - A. Orders from the Court directed to the Sheriff and/or peace officers:
 - Include civil arrests and seizures of property, with the exception of walk-in paper service, and,
 - Are executed exclusively by sworn deputies who have full police powers.
 - B. The primary responsibility for service of civil process in Weber County is with the Weber County Sheriff's Office pursuant to UCA 17-22-2.
 - C. When executing criminal and civil process deputies:
 - Will follow all statutory and case law guidelines and,
 - 2. Adequate manpower will be assigned to deter any breach of peace during execution of process.
 - D. If there is any question regarding the validity or status of documents, the deputy will contact his/her supervisor for directions.
