## 53.22 Policy

- 53.22.1 Communications personnel with the WACDC are required to utilize the Medical Priority Dispatch System, a protocol card system which guides the dispatcher through key questions, response determinants, post-dispatch instructions and pre-arrival instructions. This protocol system is required use on all medical calls received by the dispatch center.
- 53.22.2 Emergency first aid instructions are provided by dispatch personnel to all callers requesting medical assistance. The first aid instructions provided are to be followed within the Medical Priority Dispatch System.
- 53.22.3 When an officer reports the need for medical response through the dispatch center, the dispatcher will ascertain the key information needed to send the appropriate medical response.
