## 54.3 Policy

- 54.3.1 The Sheriff's Office compiles and submits IBR data monthly and annually. The IBR reports are forwarded to the Utah Bureau of Criminal Identification. This is done according to the National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS)Manual, which is retained in the records unit.
- 54.3.2 A records unit office specialist compiles statistics and completes the report monthly.
- 54.3.3 Incident Based Reporting
  - A. Weber County Sheriff's Office participates in the statewide Incident Based Reporting (IBR) system through the Bureau of Criminal Identifications.
  - B. On a monthly basis, the records supervisor will ensure that a monthly total of crimes, dollar loss and recovery, and arrests (as required by the state), will be completed.
  - C. This procedure is done on computer via diskette to the Utah State BCI repository.
  - D. A copy of the IBR reporting results is available from the State on a quarterly and annual basis.
